A friendly reminder to ensure that as a family you have a plan for your child in the rare event of a school closure due to severe weather. As a guiding principle, if The Weather Network says the wind chill in your area is lower than or at – 40C it is a **Yellow Day** for Chinook's Edge students and no busses will be running. If it says the wind chill in your area is lower than or at -45C it is a **Red Day** for Chinook's Edge students and schools will be closed. Please remember that it is up to the Parents/Guardians to make the decision to send students on Yellow Days and we will support your decision. YES Success Coaches provide classroom based universal mental health curriculum to promote awareness of mental health protective factors and enhance social and emotional development. We are happy to have Monica Gibson (Miss Monica) as our very own success coach here at Westglen School.
